Objectives

Upon completion of this program, attendees should be able to:

- Identify essential physical principles of cardiac ultrasound.
- Identify common ultrasound artifacts and their genesis and how to avoid them.
- Estimate myocardial function using standard M-mode and 2-D echocardiography as well as newer modalities such as strain imaging, vector velocity imaging, speckle tracking.
- Perform clinically relevant calculations of valve areas and intracardiac pressures.
- Apply conventional and tissue Doppler techniques to diastolic function analysis.
- Improve the accuracy of stress echo interpretations.
- Differentiate features of cardiac tamponade, constrictive pericarditis, and restrictive cardiomyopathy.
- Determine important applications of transesophageal echocardiography.
- Recognize pitfalls associated with contrast and avoiding them in daily practice.

Who should attend the course

The program is designed for adult and pediatric cardiologists, physicians who treat predominantly cardiac patients in their day-to-day clinical practice. This course would also be helpful to allied health professionals who want to pursue their future as a Echocardiographer.
